


Welcome Dinner

Highlights

Cathedral Of Thorns

The Cathedral of Thorns was designed by Herman van Bergen and is a full building-sized illuminated labyrinth completely constructed of over 1 million thorns. Visitors are invited to walk through its corridors and experience an artistic journey through a troublesome history toward a bright future; both sides are represented by the hostile yet beautiful thorns. To raise consciousness of the similarities between religions, the design includes symbols of today's world religions and ancient nature-based religions. The walls have niches containing objects of contemporary art by guest artists, expressing mankind's ability to change, share and collaborate through creativity. In addition, the labyrinth also functions as a stage for performances.

The Blue Room is one of Curacao's most famous snorkeling spots. This experience is known to exceed expectations. Originally known as Boca Fluit (Flute Bay) the Blue Room was given this name because of the whistling sounds that it emits as the water splashes against the rocks.

Highlight

Landhuis Kenepa & Tula

Once among the island's most prosperous and wealthiest plantation, Landhuis Kenepa was the site of the devastating slave rebellion that started on august 17, 1795. Led by the slave named Tula, who is Curaçao's national hero. Tula informed Kenepa landowner Casper Lodewyck van Uytrect, that the Africans captives refused to continue working on the plantation. Tula was told to go to Fort Amsterdam with his complaint, but knowing what would happen to him there, Tula and other leaders of the revolt spread out into the countryside to convince slaves from other plantations to join them in an armed fight for freedom.

Shete Boka National Park - Pocket bays

The Shete Boka National Park is an area adjoining the Christoffel Park covering almost 10 kilometers of the rocky wave-exposed north coast of the island. The park has approximately 10 pocket bays where 3 species of sea turtles are known to lay eggs. A detailed map of the pocket bays is available for purchase at the entrance of the park.
